Please respond to the following questions:

- 1. Please describe your faith journey. How did you first learn about God?
- 2. How have you experienced God in your life?
- 3. Who were the important people who helped you grow in your faith?
- 4. Share an experience of your faith being tested or having questions about God.
- 5. Tell about a time when you felt especially close to God.
- 6. What does "affirm your baptism" mean to you and why do you want to go through this rite?
- 7. How do you believe God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are at work in your life?
- 8. What relationship does your baptism have to your life as a Christian?
- 9. In what ways do you plan to live in relationship with Christ and the Church after your confirmation?
- 10. What special gifts has God given you and how do you plan to use them?
